Dr. Churchill joined the MU School of Medicine in 1987 as chair and professor of radiology. While chair, Dr. Churchill recruited a full complement of radiologists, led a growing radiology training program and directed a powerful research program.

During his 25-year tenure at MU, Dr. Churchill served in many leadership positions, culminating with his appointment as Hugh E. and Sarah D. Stephenson Dean of the Medical School in 2009.
